has helpful information to share regarding the start of the 2023-2024 school year!

If you registered your child by the deadline of June 30 and received an email revealing your child's teacher, you have this information.

Be sure to read all of the important details below **AND** click on all links!

- MEET THE TEACHER is Thursday, July 27 from 3:30-5:30!
 - Bring your child's supplies.
 - Your child's teacher will be providing you with important beginning-of-the-year paperwork and information. Make sure your teacher knows your child's method of afternoon transportation and primary contact information.

- FIRST DAY of SCHOOL for students is Monday, July 31st.
 - 1st & 2nd Grade students walk to the classroom by themselves. They are not walked to the classroom by their parents.
 - Kindergarten parents need to refer to the next bullet!
- KINDERGARTEN Parents:
 - The first school day for Kindergarten BOYS is Monday, July 31st. BOYS do
 NOT come to school on Tuesday, August 1st!
 - The first school day for Kindergarten GIRLS is Tuesday, August 1st. GIRLS do NOT come to school on Monday, July 31st!
 - Starting Wednesday, August 2nd, ALL Kindergarten BOYS & GIRLS will attend together!

- PLE School Day HOURS are:
 - Drop-off starts at 7:30. No students may be dropped off before 7:30.
 - Class starts at 8:00.
 - Students will be marked TARDY after 8:05. Teachers are no longer on duty after 8:05. Students dropped off in the carline after 8:05 MUST be signed in by their adult.
 - Afternoon BUSES begin loading at 3:00.
 - Afternoon CARLINE starts rolling immediately following the buses.

"Car Tags" (see below) will be given to all students/parents at Meet the Teachers. If the parent does not come to Meet the Teachers and, therefore, does not receive a car tag, the car tag will be sent home in the student's book bag. Be aware that, even on the first day of school, anyone without a car tag will be required to park in the PLE parking lot and report to the PLE Office with proper ID to get the student.

- ATTENDANCE will be heavily monitored this year. There may be rewards for students who demonstrate great attendance, including being on time and present for the entire school day.
 - New this school year... ALL classes in ALL grades will start their day with Reading Instruction. If your child is not in the classroom by 8:05, he or she will miss out on vital reading instruction. This could have a negative effect on more than your child's report card. This is time spent on building your child's foundation for reading success which would impact all subjects for years to come.
- Tuesday T-shirts and Order Forms will be available at Meet the Teachers. This is the ONLY t-shirt that may be worn as a Tuesday T-shirt. The district theme this year revolves around "superheroes."
